Oct 24, 2021 - Rev. Dr. John Brown. “Facing Fear in The Midst of The Unexpected”

Rev. Brown writes: My sermon will focus on the importance of understanding and coping with fear. An important Unitarian principle is to pursue, “A free and responsible search for truth and meaning.” If we are not careful, fear can sabotage this search, especially in relationship with others. All of us face unexpected events in our lives, so what are our options from a psychological and spiritual perspective?
